# Social Infrastructure



## 01. Registration of PMSBY & PMJJY

- A registration camp was organized for the PMSBY and PMJJY schemes for Bank of India and Punjab National Bank account holders, in collaboration with both banks, at Gorabali North Panchayat.
- **67 beneficiaries benefited** through the registration camp.



## 02. Medical Camp
