WATER CONSERVATION INITIATIVES:

- 3 Village ponds identified under MGNREGA for desilting and plantation
- Work completed in 2 ponds, creating 1.55Lakh KL of water holding potential annually
- ➤ Ponds will be used for irrigating 35 acres, benefiting a variety of crops and fishing

AGRICULTURE AND LIVESTOCK:

- Supported 7 progressive farmers in
 protective farming to develop
 non- sugarcane farmers
- Additional income of Rs.30k per annum <



Polyhouse (Protective Farming)

- Established 700 vermicompost units, benefiting small and marginal farmers.
- Each unit produces 1 ton of compost, sufficient for 1 acre of land, saving Rs. 22,000 input costs.
- Improved soil organic content in 17 villages.

AZOLLA CULTIVATION

- Planned 250 Azolla units with 250 identified beneficiaries.
- Demo unit established for learning and seed supply.
- ➤ Each unit yields 200 kg of feed per year, increasing milk production and weight gain in poultry and goats.
- ➤ Consistent consumption ensures an annual income of Rs. 18,500/household.

ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION

- ➤ 141 sorted and 442 conventional inseminations performed.
- ➤ Interventions resulted in birth of 67 female and 57 male calves.
- ➤ The birth of 67 female calves will significantly impact the families, potentially leading to an additional income of Rs. 9,000 per month.

A case study-Parvati Devi

Parvati Devi, a resident of Tedwa village, hails from an under privileged community. She is an active member of Jind Baba Self-Help Group (SHG), With the support of the SHG, Parvati Devi secured a loan of Rs. 40,000 to establish her own micro-enterprise. She chose to set up a mini flour mill in her home after conducting a thorough demand analysis for the area. Parvati is capable of grinding 150 to 200 kilo grams of grains, resulting in a monthly income of Rs. 9,000.




