- Yellow, white, and blue sticky traps were distributed to farmers to help control pests.
- **212** beneficiaries were benefited.
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 15,000/ - per acre.

- Distributed sewing machines to women beneficiaries from core area villages to support their livelihoods and promote skill development.
- **50** women were benefited.
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 36,000.
