- 4 Cloth Shops and 5 beauty parlors were inaugurated in the core villages.

02. Distributed Sugarcane seedlings

- 18 lakh sugarcane seedlings were distributed to 300 farmers in the core area villages.
- This initiative aims to support local farmers by providing them with high-quality seedlings, promoting better crop yields, and improving their overall agricultural productivity
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 49,500.



04. Sewing Machine Support

- **152 sewing machines** were distributed to women beneficiaries to enhance their livelihoods through tailoring.
- Each woman is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 60.000.



03. Electric Power Spray Pumps Support

- Power spray pumps were distributed to 500 households to enhance crop yield and ensure better harvests.
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 36,000.



05. Distributed Silage Bags

- **500 silage bags** were distributed to farmers to help them preserve fodder and improve their livestock management practices.
- Farmers are expected to earn annual income of Rs. 38,300 from milk sales.
