AGRICULTURE AND LIVESTOCK

- ➤ 25 farmers came together and installed an irrigation pipe line to sugarcane fields
- ➤ 2000 meters of water irrigation line was laid covering 40 acres.
- ➤ DBF contributed Rs.1 lakh for laying the pipe line for this project.
- > Farmers invested Rs.10 lakh in this project
- ➤ Each farmer is likely to earn Rs.25K additional income every year

ENTREPRENEURIAL TRAINING

- Agriculture is the main occupation in this area with dairy farming being done on a large scale.
- 30 women of Aral village were trained to process milk and make various products like khova, barfi, cheese etc.
- 5 days training was conducted in Arala village and 30 women were present.
- ➤ DBF team aims to provide business training to approximately 250 women entrepreneurs.

SUGARCANE CULTIVATION

Innovation and Success. A case study

Shirale Varun village is situated on the banks of Varana river in Shahuwadi taluka. This village has a population of 2560. Agriculture is the main occupation in this village. The dryland area of this place is large and the hilly section is wide, so rainfed crops are grown. As the agricultural area is more, it is necessary to guide the farmers to get good income in agriculture and to grow sugarcane crop and other vegetable crops. Through Dalmia Bharat Foundation, a meeting of village panchayat members and farmers of the village was organized and a guidance camp was organized on how to bring water to desired lands for irrigation.

agriculture land under irrigation Farmers who do not have water for agriculture formed a group and discussed about providing water for agriculture and with the help of Dalmia Bharat Foundation, Farmers came together and laid pipelines covering 2 kms, connecting the water source and their sugarcane fields. After the pipe line was laid, the targeted 40 acres of land came under irrigation. Due to this irrigation arrangement, around 50 farmers started earning an additional income of Rs.25K, because of increased volumen of production.
