### **MUSHROOM CULTIVATION**

- Promoted Mushroom cultivation in 17 villages in Rajgangpur and Kutra Blocks
- Mushroom Training organized with 190 members of 18 SHGs
- ➤ 137 Households have already started the intervention.
- Expected income Rs. 4,000/per month/per family

## FRUIT ORCHARD DEVELOPMENT

- Orchard Development is going on under WADI project
- ➤ 31,000 Cashew & Mango trees planted.
- Plantations cover 420 acres of land belonging to 420 households covering 41 villages.
- 23,700 number of drumsticks, lemon, papaya and teak planted as border crops.
- Vegetable cultivation done as intercropping with an expected income of Rs. 60,000p/a.



## **BACKYARD POULTRY**

- Promoted Backyard Poultry (Sonali variety) with 83 tribal families.
- Demand of this variety is very high in local market.
- It is being sold for Rs.350/Kg live bird
- Expected annual income Rs.30,000/- per family.

### **VERMI COMPOST**

- Promoted 20 vermicompost units, benefiting 20 small and marginal farmers spread across 3 villages, to improve the organic content of soil, reduce input costs, and eventually increase the yield
- → Each vermicompost unit has the annual potential to generate 1 ton of compost and will cater to 1 acre of land, which will save around Rs. 22,000 on the input costs for chemical fertilizers





### **HANDI KHATA**

- Promotion of Handi Khata (Organic pesticide) with 43 farmers in 6 villages
- This organic formulation helps to prevent a few types of plant diseases and pests, reduce application of chemicals and reduce input costs

#### **Innovation and Success. A case study**

Sabitri Patra was trained by DBF to cultivate mushroom. Sabitri learnt the trade and established her mushroom cultivation unit. She could consistently increase the production and establish rapport with multiple buyers to get the produce sold for a fair price. As days moved, she was engaged by DBF to train more beneficiaries as mushroom was well in demand throughout the year. She had trained nearly 300 women around 260 are producing mushroom, leading to a wide economic impact in the local community. Women earn around Rs.4000 per month. The efforts of Sabitri won her the title "Mushroom Lady of Lanjiberna".
